RE: ONLINE COURSES

Here are guidelines for answering questions about on-line courses.

1) The course has to be listed on our Transfer Equivalency table as equivalent at:

2) Step two is to consider which school offers the course here. Most of our schools allow courses in the on-line format, but some don't.

3) The schools that do not allow courses to be taken in the on-line format are:

- Mathematics\*
- Psychology
- All of the Lab Sciences
- Economics
- History: HIST 2111 and HIST 2112
- International Affairs

\*NOTE:

If the student, in the case of Math, can provide evidence that their exams are proctored, then they can request that Math take a look at that specific on-line course at that specific school. If the student cannot provide proof that the exams were proctored, the on-line course will not be acceptable.
